July 28, 1774, when Stebbins was twenty-four years old, the spirit of patriotism of the Sons of Liberty had reached such a height that preparations had been made for setting up a tall Liberty Pole upon the village street. Party spirit ran high, and little courtesy was shown on either side. There were a few Tories in town, and this Pole, which had been brought...
